Featuring speaker and special guest:
Dr. Ilana Horn, Vanderbilt University

Ilana Seidel Horn is Professor of Mathematics Education at Vanderbilt University Peabody College. She studies secondary mathematics teachers' learning by looking at teachers in their workplace settings to understand the problems of practice they *actually* grapple with. Her research aims to better understand ways to support teachers' on-the-ground problem solving to improve mathematics teaching and learning, especially in urban settings.



Keynote:

Designing Motivational Math Classrooms: Helping Students to Share Their Ideas

Mathematics teaching is most effective when instruction builds on student thinking. But what are teachers supposed to do when students don't *want* to share their thinking? Dr. Horn answers this question by reporting on what she learned by examining the classroom instruction of 6 highly accomplished secondary math teachers, all of whom are known for encouraging students to share their math ideas. Merging an analysis of their practice with the psychology of motivation, she offers a framework for how teachers can re-design their classrooms to help all students participate in meaningful mathematics learning.
